## **JOIN OUR TEAM:**

The Sutter Creek Police Department is accepting applications to establish a recruitment list for full time and reserve police officers. Those with POST certification, recent academy graduates or currently enrolled in a police academy are encouraged to apply. The City of Sutter Creek is a small historic city of approximately 2,500 residents located in Amador County. It is just a short distance from Sacramento and Stockton.

Sutter Creek is about 2.5 square miles in size and at about 1100 feet above sea level, putting it above the fog of the Sacramento Valley and just below the snow of the Sierra Mountains, making it the perfect base for a wide range of outdoor activities in the area.

## **THE DEPARTMENT:**

The members of the Sutter Creek Police Department are dedicated to fostering a continual partnership between the community and the police, as well as engaging in a collaborative effort to improve the quality of life for all in our community. The department is staffed by a Chief and four sworn patrol officers. In addition, the department has a reserve police officer program and a newly started cadet program.

## **THE POSITION:**

Perform general law enforcement and crime prevention work, conduct traffic enforcement and enforce State and local municipal codes, perform investigative work and perform a variety of technical and administrative tasks in support of the Department.

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

### **Experience:**

Basic P.O.S.T. Certificate or current enrollment in or completion of a P.O.S.T. approved basic academy.

### **Education:**

High School graduate or equivalent. Possession of an Associate of Arts degree is desirable but not required.

### **License or Certificate:**

Possession of a valid California driver's license at time of appointment.

### **Additional Requirements:**

Must be 21 years of age at time of appointment.

Must meet physical requirements of the job established by the Department.

### **Salary**

- \$4,109.73-\$4,995.41 per month plus holiday pay.
- P.O.S.T. Certificate/Educational Incentive—Additional 2.5% for Intermediate Certificate and/or A.A. Degree and an additional 2.5% for Advanced Certificate and/or B.A. Degree.
- CalPERS enrollment in the 3% @ 50 formula. Employee pays the 9% member contribution. The City participates in Social Security and Medicare.
- Excellent health benefits with the City of Sutter Creek contributing up to \$1333 per month towards medical, dental and vision coverage.
- \$100 a month uniform allowance.

### **Holidays**

The City of Sutter Creek employees are entitled to 11 paid holidays per year.

### **Vacation**

80 hours annually increasing to 160 hours based upon years of service

### **Sick Leave**

Accrues at 3.7 hours per pay period (96 hours annually)
