

The Amador County Recreation Agency (ACRA) is proud to bring swimming lessons to Sutter Creek. ACRA will provide Certified Red Cross Swim Instructors and lifeguards to give up-to-date swimming lesson techniques and teach safe recreational swimming.

We are committed to keeping control over a sometimes difficult environment. We assure all patrons that safety is our number one concern. But in turn, patrons must keep in mind that the lifeguards are in control at all times and have been hired to guard the lives of the swimmers in the pool, not oversee children in the park area. Any patron who does not obey a lifeguard is subject to expulsion from the Sutter Creek Pool. **Please remember the lifeguards are not babysitters and children 8 and under must be accompanied by an adult.** Please be kind and courteous and you will be treated with the utmost respect.

CLOSURE POLICY - The Amador County Health Codes dictates that the pool will be closed due to fecal contamination. Please respect our need to comply with this rule which our staff must enforce.

The pool will also be closed on poor air quality days and during lightening storms.
