



The Knight Foundry

After nearly two decades of negotiations, the City of Sutter Creek has obtained title to the Knight Foundry complex, and we are now in a position to forever preserve this unique asset for our community. The City Council has adopted a long-range plan for the Foundry with this mission:

“To protect, preserve, and restore the Knight Foundry’s historic structures, features and operations in order to convey its local and regional importance as a unique 19th century industrial facility.”

In January the Knight Foundry Alliance was formed, and its group of City Council members and enthusiastic volunteers are tasked with finalizing the purchase and implementation of urgent security and stabilization repairs. The alliance is working closely with the City of Sutter Creek and the Amador Community Foundation to generate the funds necessary to finalize the purchase and launch restoration projects.
