

**RESOLUTION NO. 13-14-19**  
**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUTTER CREEK**  
**RECOMMENDING WATER USERS IN SUTTER CREEK IMPLEMENT**  
**VOLUNTARY WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES**

**WHEREAS**, on January 14, 2014, Governor Jerry Brown declared a water emergency for the state of California, and

**WHEREAS**, Governor Brown has requested that all water users voluntarily conserve water to a 20% level; and

**WHEREAS**, the Amador Water Agency Board of Directors at its January 23, 2014 special meeting asked its customers to implement voluntary water conservation measures consistent with the Governor's request;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

The City Council of Sutter Creek hereby recommends all water users within Sutter Creek voluntarily conserve water employing as appropriate and at minimum the following techniques:

1. Sweep paved areas rather than washing with a hose.
2. Fix all plumbing leaks promptly
3. Turn the water off while shaving or brushing teeth
4. Run dishwashers and clothes washers only when full
5. Inspect irrigation systems, repair leaks, adjust spray heads to prevent overspray, and set timers for minimizing water days.
6. Keep the length of showers to 5 minutes or less
7. When washing dishes in the sink, avoid running the water by filling the sink for washing and rinsing.
8. Any other water conservation measures that may be appropriate for individual households and businesses.

**The foregoing resolution was passed and adopted** by the City Council of Sutter Creek at a Regular Meeting held on the 3rd day of February 2014 by the following vote:


